

The Wyalusing Municipal Authority was established to oversee the day to day operations of the water and sewer utilities in the Borough of Wyalusing. Although the Wyalusing Borough is the owner of the utilities, the Authority supervises the maintenance, testing and filing of required paperwork requested by DEP; billing; and the removal of sludge to the Northern Tier Solid Waste Authority in Burlington, PA.

To improve communication between the Borough and Authority, a liaison is appointed. This liaison attends both entities' regular monthly meetings.

Any financial concerns such as budgets or rate changes must first be approved by the Wyalusing Borough before either can be adopted by the Wyalusing Municipal Authority.

At the present time, the rates for water and sewer are as follows:

- Water = 4,000 gallon minimum -- \$20/month/customer; \$0.005/gallon after 4,000 gallons
- Sewer = 4,000 gallon minimum -- \$28/month/customer; \$0.007/gallon after 4,000 gallons
- Usage beyond 4,000 gallons/month charged by the gallon based on the water meter (with the exception of sewer only customers)

Water and Sewer connection fees are as follows:

- Water Connection Fee = \$500.00
- Sewer Connection Fee = \$1,000.00

The Wyalusing Municipal Authority meets the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. at the Wyalusing Borough Hall unless otherwise advertised. These meetings are open to the public.
