ORDINANCE NO 61

AN ORDINANCE, AMBULANCE SERVICES, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WYALUSING, COUNTY OF BRADFORD, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

Wyalusing Borough hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Chapter 58. Ambulance Service

The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate Ambulance Services as authorized under the Borough Code found at 35 Pa.C.S.A. 7101.

§ 58-1. Designation.

The Wyalusing Valley Volunteer Fire Department consists of active fire, rescue and E.M.S. personnel. The Wyalusing Valley Volunteer Fire Department provides emergency medical services to Wyalusing Borough. The Wyalusing Valley Volunteer Fire Department, organized and consisting of Wyalusing Ambulance service, existing in the Borough of Wyalusing, Bradford County, Pennsylvania, and hereafter known as the "ambulance service," is hereby designated as an officially recognized ambulance service for the Borough of Wyalusing.

§ 58-2. Authorized activities of service.

A.

The ambulance service recognized by the Borough of Wyalusing is hereby authorized to provide such services to the Borough of Wyalusing as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons therein, which includes, by way of example and not of limitation, the transportation of persons to and from medical facilities and residents, the extrication of persons from hazardous situations of entrapment, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents up to an operations level or other situations.

B.

The ambulance service may also provide nonemergency and public service functions, such as, again by way of example and not of limitation, standbys at public and private events, such as community events, County Fair and assisting in removal, abatement and prevention of damage or injury to persons or property, whether through natural causes or man-made situations.

C.

The ambulance service may also conduct and participate in such training activities and drills, either in or outside of the Wyalusing Borough, as may be deemed necessary by officers of the department to maintain proficiency in providing service.

D.

The ambulance service may also respond to calls and provide services to municipalities outside of the Borough of Wyalusing pursuant to mutual aid agreements, licenser agreements or legislative requirements.

§ 58-3. Authorized activities of members.

In addition to actually participating in the activities of the ambulance service as authorized above, or in going to or returning from any activity, the members of the ambulance service, recognized by the Borough of Wyalusing, are also authorized to do the following:

A.

Engage in any type of drill, training, ceremony, contest, practice, test, parade, public education or inspection when duly called for or authorized by an officer or officers of the ambulance service;

B.

Engage in fund-raising activities for the ambulance service, when authorized by an officer or officers of the ambulance service;

C.

Engage in the performance of any duty or activity authorized by an officer of the recognized ambulance service.

§ 58-4. Purpose.


The purpose of this chapter is to recognize the Wyalusing Fire Department, volunteer members for workmen's compensation purposes.


§ 58-5. Severability.

In the event that any individual section or provision within this article shall be found invalid, the invalidity shall pertain only to the specific section, and all other aspects of this article shall remain in full force and effect.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
